- **First Reconciliation** — February 23, 2019 [Saturday] 11:00am, in the Church

- Arrival:** Communicants should meet in the Parish Center at **10:45am**. The procession line will form in the main hall (atrium). Mass begins promptly at 11:00am
- Attire:** **BOYS:** White shirt, dark pants, and a dark solid tie. Dark socks and dress shoes. No athletic shoes.
GIRLS: White dress, white veil or hair band (e.g. wreath of flowers), white socks or tights, and white shoes.
- Photos:** In order to be attentive to the reverence of the liturgy and the solemnity of the occasion, no photography is permitted during Mass. Each candidate will receive a professional individual photo of their receiving Communion. Photographs may be taken after the Mass.
- Reception:** First Communicants and their families are invited to a reception in Feeney Hall immediately following the First communion liturgy. Please come join us!

- Arrival:** Please arrive at the Church by **10:50am**. We will begin promptly at 11:00. In the vestibule, please sign in prior to entering the Church. Your child should also pick up a guide to Confession to take with to his or her seat.
- Itinerary:**
- Children will sit in the front center pews. Parents and others may sit elsewhere.
 - Father will begin the service with a short prayer and inform the children of where the stations for Confession are located.
 - Teachers will guide the children to each priest in an orderly fashion.
 - When each child is done with their Confession, they should find their parent(s). Parents, please pray the penance with your children.
 - Once you and your child are done, you may stay for as long as you like and leave when you are done
